OFFICE OF THE VICE PROVOST FOR FACULTY AFFAIRS

- At its November 30, 2021, meeting, the Faculty Senate passed a report recommending changes to AC80 – Outside Business Activities and Private Consulting. This revision effectively consolidated AD77 and AC80, and AD77 is now under revision and will pertain only to staff.
- The changes to AC80 have been implemented and the [revised policy](#) became effective April 5, 2022. The team in the Office for Research Protections have drafted an informational web page to educate faculty on the changes and it is found at <https://www.research.psu.edu/node/5159>.
- The College is also required to review our existing AD77 guidelines to make sure they are applicable to the new AC80 policy by December 15, 2022, and a subcommittee of the College's Executive Council will be charged with doing that. Revisions to the College guidelines will be distributed in the College Digest and posted on the College's website in due course.
